## Petersbourg, December 2.

WO Persian Ambassadours had the 28th paft their firft Audience of her Majeity. The 30th of laft Month being St. Andrew's Day, Patron of the Order of the Blue Ribbon, all the Foreign Ministers and Russian Nobility went in the Morning to compliment the Czarina on the Occafion. Her Majetty went to Church attended by all the Knights of St. Andrew, dreffed in the Habit and Collar of the Order; after Divine Service was over they had the Honour to dine with her Majefty; and at Night there was a Ball. Some Days ago M. Calfo, a Captain in the King of Pruflia's own Regiment of Grenadiers, arrived here with the Tall Man that was carried away by force fome Months ago from Courland. He has brought with him two Sets of very fine Coach Horfes, which the! King of Pruffia has fent as Prefents, one Set to the Czarina, and the other to the Duke of Courland, with a Magnificent Pha-

Warfaw, Dec. 24. On the 18th the King and Queen went fome Miles from hence to a Hunting of the wild Boar, and their Majesties returned in the Evening. The next Day the King nominated the Cardinal Bilhop of Cracos to the Archbishoprick of Gnefna, by which his Eminence became Primate of Poland; proper Notification of which was dispatched to Rome, in order to have the Pope's Confirmation ; And his Eminence received the Compliments of all Perfons of Diflinction at the Court, upon the King's ha-ving conferr'd on him the first Dignity of the Kingdom next to the Crown. On the 20th this Prelate had Audience of their Polifh Majeffies, to return his Thanks, and that Day dined at Court. Count Sedlnicki, Palatine of Podlachia, being nominated Marshal of the Court to the Queen; has begun to act in that Office, which became vacant fome Months ago by the Death of the Castellan of Radom Dunin. M. Poninski Referendary

of the Crown having been nominated Palatine of Posnania, has taken the usual Oath in that Quality to the King; and his Son, the Staroft of Petrikow, is made Chamber-lain to the King. Baron Keyferling Minister Plenipotentiary from the Czarina, having obtain'd Leave from his Court to repair thi-ther, fet out on the 22d. Count Flemming great Mafter of the Artillery of Lithuania, has taken the Opportunity of accompanying him, to fee the Court of Ruffia. Berlin, Dec. 27, N.S. M. Viebahn and Major General Kalkenstein, two of his Pru-

ffian Majefties Commiffiaries at the Conferences held at Baruth, who had been here for a fhort Time, returned a few Days ago to that Place; and it is faid, that the Buli-nels of the Cartel, and fome Difputes about Commerce, between this Court and that of Drefden, will be foon fettled to the Satisfaction of both Parties. His Pruffian Majefty is still confined to his Chamber with the Gout.

## Whitehall, December 29, 1738.

Whereas at a Seffions of Oyer and Terminer, held for the Jurisation of the Admiralty of England, on Friday the 10th Day of November last at the Old Bailey, James Buchanan was convicted of a Murder committed upon the High Seas, and was ordered to be Executed for the fame on Wednefday the 20th Day of this Instant December, at Execution Dock in Wapping ; but before the faid James Buchanan had hung the u'ualTime, some evil-disposed Persons cut him down, and carried him away; and there being Reason to believe that the faid James Buchanan was not fully executed, as the Law requires, but is now living ; For the better dif-Law requires, but is now living; For the better dif-covering and bringing to Juftice the Perfons concerned in the refcuing of the faid James Buchanan, His Ma-jefty is pleafed to promife his most gracious Pardon to any one of them, (except the Perfon or Perfons who attually cut the fiid James Buchanan down) who shall difcover his Accomplice or Accomplices, fo as he or they may be apprehended and convicted hereof.
