**Admiralty Office, July 10, 1739.**

It is the Directions of the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, that all such Men who have voluntarily enter'd themselves, in or about the City of London, or that shall hereafter so enter, do forbear with repair on board the respective Ships they enter to serve in, excepting the Press Gangs who may be employed with the Lieutenants in raising Men for the Fleet, otherwise they will forfeit the Benefit promis'd them by his Majesty's late Royal Proclamation; and Notice is hereby given, that they must apply to the Principal Officers and Commissioners of the Navy for Conduct-Money, if the Ships they have entered to serve in be at Chatham, at the Bay of the Neve, or in the Downs; or if at Portsmouth or Spithead, for Conduct-Money, and Carriage for their Chests and Bedding, not exceeding One Hundred Weight. And if there are any Men in or about the Town who have enter'd for the Ships at Plymouth, they are also to apply to the Navy Board for Conduct-Money, and Carriage for their Chests and Bedding to Port-
