N the 19th Instant our Regency ordered three Physicians and twelve Surgeons to repair forthwith to the Frontiers of Hungary, and use the neceflary Precautions for preventing the bring-ing in of the Plague by the Saxon Troops in their Return from Hungary to their own Country. Those Troops are to be quartered in the Counties of Tirnau, Liptau, and Trenfcheen, to perform Quarantain for fome Time, during which every Soldier is to be vifited and examined daily by the faid Phylicians and Surgeons; and none of them are to proceed on their March, till those Physicians, who have been solemnly fworn to do their Duty faithfully, certify that they are free from any

contagious Diffemper. Vienna, Jan. 2, N. S. The Emperour has appointed Count Uhlefeld, his Ambaf-fadour and Minister Plenipotentiary to the States General of the United Netherlands, to go with the Character of Ambassadour to the Ottoman Porte. An Express from Rome having brought Advice of the Death of Count Harrach, his Imperial Majesty's Ambaffadour at that Court; Count Daun, Auditor of the Rota, is appointed to fucceed him. The Prince of Saxe-Hildburghaufen, and the Generals Damnitz, Piccolomini, Ciceri, and Daun, having feverally perform'd Quarantain, are arrived here from Hungary.
