### Naples, December 22.

HE Council of Commerce lately eftablished here, is vested with great Powers, and especially to decide as Judges all Difputes that may relate to Traffick by Sea or Land. They propose to improve the Manufactures now carried on in this Kingdom, and to fet up and encourage others. The great Difficulty will be to induce a People accuftomed to Sloth and Idleness, to relish Work, tho' for The great Difficulty their better Maintenance. A Society is formed for erecting a Printing-house in this Capital: And they propose to begin by printing Missals, Breviaries, and other Books for the Service of the Church, with which we have hitherto been furnished by Foreigners. They will for the prefent make Ule of Letter caft at Florence.

Modena, Dec. 24, N. S. The Duke our Sovereign holds frequent Councils with his Minifters for well regulating the publick Af-fairs, and particularly for promoting Com-merce. By the Marriage of the Hereditary Prince with the young Dutchess of Malla, the two Dominions being become united, the Duke of Modena and the Regent Dutcheis of Maffa have agreed, and have already fet Men to Work, to make a High-Road in the Moun. tains which separate the Modenese from the Dutchy of Mafla and Carrara. That Work is fuspended at present on Account of the bad Weather, but will be renewed in the Begin-ning of next Spring. This will be of great Advantage, not only to the Dutchies of Modena and Maila, but to great Part of Italy. For, Goods may be brought up hither by Water from Venice, Triefte, and Fiume, and be carried from hence by Land to Carrara on the Coaft of the Mediterranean, whence they may be fent by Shipping to Leghorn, Genoa, Naples, Marfeilles, and other Ports; from which Ports Goods may in like Manner be conveyed by Sea to Carrara, and thence by Land hither, and fent from hence by Water to the Ports in the Adriatick.
