## Hambourg, February 10, N. S.

RINCE Augustus of Holstein having accompanied his Brother the Bishop of Lubeck to this City, returned Yes-terday to Kiel. His Highnels will come back to this Place towards the Beginning of next Month, and then fet out for Holland, from whence he will proceed to Ypres, where his Regiment in the Dutch Service is in Garrifon.

Berlin, Feb. 11. His Pruffian Majesty has been pleased to appoint M. Borck, late his Minister at Vienna, to be a Minister of State in the Department for Foreign Affairs, in the Room of M. Thulemeyer, deceafed. The laft Letters from Silelia fay, that the Caftle of Namflaw, fituate on the Frontiers of Poland, had furrendred, and that the Pruffians found there a Magazine of Provisions and Ammunition, and took between two and three Hundred Prisoners.
