## Petersbourg, January 27.

Eneral Lowendahl is arrived here from his Government at Revel : He was fent for now, as he was laft Summer, to regulate feveral Things belonging to the Train of Artillery. As his Lady is to follow him, it is thought that he will make fome Stay here, and a Notion prevails, that he may probably be placed in the Council of War. The Saxon Colonel Neubour fet out laft Night on his Return to Drefden. General Uxkall, a Livonian Gentleman of a good Family and Eftate, who is in this Service, has been lately plut under Arreft, and it is faid that a Council of War will be appointed to fit upon him. Antwerp, Feb. 22, N.S. The Differences which have of late lubifited between the Government of Brullels and that of Liege, were adjusted fome Days fince by a Provisional Agreement, which reftores the free Intercourfe of Commerce between the faid Countries, and leaves Things upon the fame Foot they were when the Archdutchels aflured the Government of the Low Countries, till fuch Time as they shall be farther and more finally fettled in the Conferences which are appointed to be held for that Purpofe within the Space of three Months.
