THE Marquis de Vallory, the French Minister, having received an Express from his Court, in the Night between the 4th and 5th Instant, set out Yesterday Morning early for Silesia. Besides the seven Regiments of Foot, which it is said are raising in Silesia, his Prussian Majesty has ordered two new Regiments of Dragoons to be forthwith raised, each of 10 Squadrons: One is to be commanded by Count Rottembourg, lately arrived from Paris; and the other by M. Nassau, a Silesian, who has been Colonel of Horse in the Saxon Service. There is also a Talk of two more Regiments of Dragoons, one of five Squadrons to be raised by M. Knobeldorf, and another of 10 Squadrons to be raised by Major General Reitzel, who quitted the Austrian Service some Months ago.
