IS Majesty came this Day to the Houle of Peers, and being in His Royal Robes, feated on the Throne with the usual Solemnity, SirCharles Dalton, Gentleman-Uiher of the Black Rod, was fent with a Mellage from His Majesty to the Houle of Commons, commanding their Attendance in the Houle of Peers; the Commons being come thither accordingly, His Majesty was pleased to give the Royal Affent to,

An Act for continuing the Duties upon Malt, Mum, Cyder and Perry, in that Part of Great Britain called England; and for granting to bis Majesty certain Duties upon Malt, Mum, Cyder and Perry in that Part of Great Britain called Scotland, for the Service of the Year One thousand Seven hundred and forty one.

An Act to prohibit for a Time therein limited, the Exportation of Corn, Grain, (Rice excepted) Meal, Malt, Flour, Bread, Bifcuit, Starch, Beef, Pork and Bacon.

An Act for punishing Mutiny and Defertion; and for the better Payment of the Army and their Quarters

An Act to indemnify Perfons who have bmitted to Qualify themiselves for Offices and Imployments within the Time limited by Law, and for allowing further Time for that Purpofer

An Act for granting and continuing the Duties upon Salt, and upon red and white Herrings, for the further Term of feven Yeart; and for al-lowing Rock Salt to be used in making of Salt from Sea Water at the Salt Works at Neath in the County of Glamorgan.

An Act to indemnify Protestant Purchasers of Estates of Papists against the Penalties or For-feitures Papists are liable to for not having in-rolled their Estates, in pursuance of an Ast of the third Year of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the first for that Purpose.

An Act to render the Laws more effectual for preventing the stealing and destroying of Sheep and other Cattle.

An Act to impower Joseph Porter, James Bourdieu and Abraham Desmarette, to import a certain Quantity of Raw Silk of the Growth of

Spain from Leghorn. An Act for making the Chapelry of Nether Knutsford in the Parish of Rostbern and County of Chester a separate and distinct Parish; and for erecting a Parify Church therein, endowing the fame, fettling the Right of Prefentation thereto, and other Purpofes.

An Act for licenfing the Importation of Victual from Ireland and other Parts beyond the Seas into Scotla, Time of Dearth and Scarcity.

An net to explain and amend an Ast made in the third Year of the Reign of King James the Fird, initiled, An Act for the Recovery of Imall Debts, and for the relieving of poor Debtors in London.

An Act for incorporating the Undertakers of

the Navigation of the River Dee. An Act to prevent Inconveniencies arifing from. Delays of Causes after Issue joined.

+ An Act for fupplying the Gity of Gloucester with fresh Water. .

An Act to amend the Law concerning common Recoveries; and to explain and amend an Act made in the twenty ninth Year of the Reign of King Charles the Second, intitled, An Act for prevention of Frauds and Perjuries fo far as the fame relates to Estates per auter vie.

An Act for repairing the Road from Wakefield to Pontefract, and from thence to a Place called Weeland in the Township of Hensall; and from Pontefract to Wentbridge in the Township of Darrington, in the West Riding of the County of York.

An Act for enlarging the Term ant Powers granted by an Act paffed in the twelfth Year of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the First, intitled, An Act for repairing and widening the Road from Horfley Upright Gate leading down Bowden Hill, in the County of Wilts, to the Top of Kingsdown Hill in the Parifs of Box in the faid County.

An Act for repairing the Roads from Doncaster through Ferry Bridge to the South Side of Tadcaster Cross; and also from Ferry Bridge to Weatherby, and from thence to Burrough Bridge in the Gounty of York.

An Act for enlarging the Terms and Powers granted by an Act made in the Twelfth Year of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the First, intitled, An Act far repairing the Roads in the Parifbes of Kenfington, Chelfea, and Fulham, and other Parifbes therein mentioned in the County of Middlefex; and for repairing fome other Roads in the Parish of St. George Hanover-square, and the faid Parifies of Kenfington and Chelfea.

An Act for enlarging the Terms and Powers granted by two Acts of Parliament for repairing the Roads leading from Seven Oaks to Woodfgate and Tunbridge Wells, and from Wood/guis to Rippings Crojs in the County of Kent; and also, for repairing the Roads from Kippings Grojs afore faid to Lamberhurft Pound and Pullen's Hill in the faid County, and to Flintwell Vent in the County of Suffex.
