By the Lords Juffices and Council of Ireland,

A PROCLAMATION

Requiring Quarantine to be performed by all Ships and Vessels coming from the Island of Sicily, or from or through the Mediterranean.

John Armagb. Robt. Jocelyn, C. Hen. Boyle. HEREAS upon Information given to this Board, That the Ifland of Sicily was vifited with the Plague, We the Lords Juffices and Council,

in order to prevent the Injection being brought by Ships or Veffels coming from thence, or other Places in the Mediterranean, into any of the Ports of this Kingdom, did, by our Proclama-tion, bearing Date the Eighteenth Day of July laft, Order, That all Ships or Veffels then arrived and not unladen, and all Ships and Veffels, which fhould therea ter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom from the laid Island of Sicily, should make their Quarantine for forty Days; and that all Ships and Veffels that were then arrived, and not unladen, or thould thereatter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom from any other of the Ports in the Mediterranean, fhould make their Quaran-tine for fourteen Days. We the Lords Juffices and Council judging it neceflary (for the further preventing the faid Infection from being brought into this Kingdom) to make feveral Alterations and Additions to our faid Proclamation of the Eighteenth of July laft, do hereby Order, That all Ships or Veflels already arrived and not yet unladen, and all Ships or Veflels which shall hereaster arrive in any Port of this Kingdom from or through the Mediterranean (except the Island of Sicily) do make their Quarantine for fourteen Days; and all fuch Ships and Veffels as are arrived and not yet unladen, or that fhall herea ter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom from the faid Ifland of Sicily, do make their Quarantine for forty Days; which refpective 7 mes are to be reckoned from the Day each Ship or Veffel shall come to Anchor in the

Place appointed for performing fuch Quarantine, and not before.

That the Places for performing Quarantine by fuch Ships and Veffels, bound to any Port between Miffen-Head and the Tuskard, be the Bay of Baltimore. And for fuch Ships and Veffels as fhall be bound for any Port between Tuskard and Rathlin, be Lough-Learn and the Bay of Carlingford, near Killowen Point, oppofite the Town of Carlingford. And for fuch Ships and Veffels as fhall be bound for any Port between Rathlin and Torry-Ifland, be Ballymaîtoker Bay or Red-Caftle Road, near Londonderry. And for fuch Ships and Veffels as fhall be bound to any Port between Torry-Ifland and Black-Sod Bay, be the Harbour of Killybeggs. And for fuch Ships and Veffels as fhall be bound to any Port between Black-Sod Bay and Loop-Head, be Clew-Bay (otherwife called) the Bay of Burrifhowle. And for fuch Ships and Veffels as fhall be bound to any Port between Loop-Head and Miffen-Head, be Scattery Road, in the River of Limerick.

That until and during the Time for making fuch Quarantine, the Perfon coming, or Goods imported in any fuch Ship or Veffel, fhall come on Shore, or be landed in any Place within this Kingdom.

That no Pilots fhall go on board any Ship or Veffel obliged to perform Quarantine, in order to conduct the fame into any Port or Place, but thall perform fuch Service in fome other Boat or Veffel; which Boat or Veffel fhall keep as much to the Windward of the Ship or Veffel, fo to be conducted, as poffible: And if any Pilot or other Perfon fhall go on board fuch Ship or Veffel, fuch Pilot or other Perfon fhall perform Quarantine in like Manner as any Perfon coming in fuch Ship or Veffel fhall be obliged to perform the fame.

That if, at the Expiration of the Forty Days Quarantine to be performed by any Ship or Veffel that is or fhall be liable thereto, it fhall appear to the Officers of the Cuftoms in the Place where fuch Ship or Veffel fhall be, and the Mafter
