Ignior Quirini, Ambaffador for this State at the Port, hath at his earnest instance, obtained leave to return hither ; and in the mean time the Sena e is about making choice of his Suc-reffor. Not Aithflanding our last Letters from Corfu affured us, that the Plague was wholly ceafed there, yet our Magiltrates have not thought fit to take off the Quarantine, which the Ships which come from thence are obliged to make, though inflead of fix weeks, the torm is onely now Fifteen days. Our Letters from the Port rell us, That the Grand Signior, who had been fome time in Siliffria, to bring his Forces together against next Spring, when he intended to have fallen into Pgland, was returned to Adrianople, very much furpri-zed to hear that that Crown had prevented him, in beginning first an offensive War, and in a season so much advanced; that to add to the diforder this unexpected much of the Poles had put the affairs of the Turks in, "They had advice that the Hofpodars of Moldavia and Walachia were about quitting their Interests, and put-sting themselves under the protection of the Poles, which will be a great blow to them in this Conjuncture.

Warfam, Iteg. 16. Our Letters now tell us, That the Crown-General Sobletski will not come hither, to be prefent at the Election, but will continue on the Frontiens, where his prefence is more necessary to have an eye upon the actions of the Enemy; and belides, shis Friends are of opinion, that while he is thus taking care of the affairs of the Kingdom, his prefences to the The faid General has Crown may focceed the better. fent fome Troops under the Command of the Crown-Standard-bearer into Walachia, the better to fecure that Countrey in their Allegiance to this Crown ; and has quartered another part of his Forces round about Caminiecs and by that means fo straightly befet the place, that not any Provisions can be brought into it; The Turks hereupon have quitted fallowic, and are retired into the Ukrain and our Troops have taken poffeffion of it; The General hath likewife fent a good body of Men into the Ukrain, who are to lye at Megibos to observe the Turks on that fide; the reft of our Forces are put into their winter Quarters near Lemburgh. We are in great hopes that this approaching Election will be carried on without any diforder, all perfons agreeing in this, That it extreamly concerns the wel-ture of the Kingdom, that they have a King as foon as may be. The Corps of the late King are brought into the. Callle, where it lies exposed on a Bed of State in the most folemu manner, coustantly attended by feveral of the Nobility, and the late fervants to his Majesty,

Nambourgh, Dec. 29. Our Letters from Denmark sell us, That that Crown had nied feveral endeavors to oppose the Treaty now lately concluded between the King of Sweden and the Elector of Brandenburgh, but finding they had been without effect, his Majesty of

Denmiath now defires to be admitted into that Alliance, which the States-General of the United Provinces hinder as much as poffibly they can, and as weare told offer a monthly Subfidy of 45000 Crowns per month, to draw his Majeffy to imbrace their party. In Germany preparations are every where making for War; the Emperor is railing of Men, the feveral Circles are bringing their Forces into the Field againft Spring; The Elector of Bavaria, jealous of the proceedings of the Emperor, reinforces his Troops, and hath commanded thefe he has now on foot, to march towards his Frontiers. From Stock balme we have dvice, That the King was returned thicker, and the enhabitants of that place, to express their power have dvice, That the Regency has possible receiver the feether in a public Reception; That the Regency has possibly refolved to lave this Spring a confiderable Army together in their Territories in Germany, to act with them, as may he molt neceffary for the reftoring of Peace to the Empire. The States of the Empire alfembled here; having upon the Receipt of the Empire alfembled here; having upon the Receipt of the Emperors approbation of their late' refolution concerning the General Arming, refolved, That the feveral Officers which were formerly cholen to command the Forces of the Ten Circles, fhould repair fitcher against the Twentieth of February next, the Billar of Around the Forces of Imperial Committioner, hath accordingly dispatched his Letters to the feveral perfons concerned, to give them notice hereof. It is confidently faid, That the Elector of Saxony will affer the Emperor with 4000 Men, and befides, That he there permitted Levies to be made in his Territories for his Imperial Maj fly. The Emperor hath put fome Trans Interference and the Frontiers of the Apper Basiara, Mar Elector, has caufed his Forces to march, to ference his own Territories.

Vienna, Dec. 27. His Imperial Majefty, cohlidering the great age of the Count de Monteciucit, has, it is faid, given him leave to quit the Command of his Forces, for which his Imperial Majefty, according to the general opinion, has defigned the Prince of Baden Dourlach; The new Levies are to confift of Fifteen thousand Men, and are carrying on with great diligence? The feveral Circles of the Empire will likewife have their Forces on foot in the Spring, but how they will act with them is as yet a queffion. From Turky we have advice, that that Court was much troubled at the news they had received of the defeat of their Forces by the Poles, that the Grand Signior had given Orders to repair this lofs, for the bringing all his Forces rogether, and their marching towards Poland, but that the Plague which rages extreamly among them, hinders very much the execution of their Orders.
