A T the Court at Kensington, the 8th Day of September, 1747,

or caufe to be bought, fold, or exposed, or offered to Sale, any Ox, Bull, Cow, Calf, Steer, or Heifer, in any Fair, Market, Town, Parish or Extraparochial Place whatfover, except only fatted Cattle ready for immediate Slaughter. Provided nevertheless, that nothing herein contained, is meant or intended to take away the Whereas on the eighteenth Day of June last, his Majesty was pleased, by his Order made in his Privy Council, to establish several Liberty granted by his Majesty's Order of Council of the 18th of June last, for re-moving Cattle from one Pasture to ano-ther, though the fame should be in diffe-Liberty granted by his Majesty's Order of tent Parishes, or to drive Ox-Teams in any kind of Carriages from one Parish or Place to another, provided the feveral Conditions, required by the faid Order of Council in the faid respective Cases, be in all Things strictly and duly complied with. And for the greater Certainty that the fatted Cattle are not infected, or come from any infected Place or Herd, his Majesty doth hereby further require and command, That no Perfon or Perfons whatsoever do buy, sell, or expose, or offer to Sale, or caufe to be bought; fold, or exposed, or offered to Sale, any fuch fatted Cattle, unlefs the Perfon or Perfons driving, fending or removing, or felling fuch Cattle, do deliver, or caufe to be delivered to the Person or Persons who shall buy the fame, a Certificate under the Hand and Seal, or Hands and Seals, of one or more Justice or Justices of the Peace for the County, Riding, Division, City, Liberty or Town Corporate, or of one or more Commissioner or Commissioners of the Land-Tax, qualified to act herein, for the County, Riding or Division, where the Town, Parish or Extraparochial Place shall lie, from whence fuch Cattle shall be driven; or (in Cafe no Justice of the Peace, or Commissioner of the Land-Tax as aforefaid, shall be refident at that Time, within three Miles of fuch Parish or Place) of the Rector, Vicar, or Curate of fuch Parish, or of some neighbouring Parish, attested by one of the Churchwardens or Overseers Key of the Poor of the Parish or Place from whence such Cattle shall be brought de, remov'd, specifying the Name or Name, Same and Place or Places of Abode of the Per fon or Perfons selling the same; and that

Rules, Orders, and Regulations, for the better preventing the Spreading of the Distemper amongst the Horned Cattle; Which Rules, Orders, and Regulations were thereby directed to be carefully obferved, and to continue in Force for and during the Space of three Calendar Months, to commence from the first Day of July last: And whereas his Majesty hath received Information, that the faid Diftemper hath of late greatly increased, and extended itself into many Parts of this Kingdom which had been entirely free therefrom; and that this had been occafioned chiefly through the Neglect of the Officers appointed to carry the faid Rules, Orders, and Regulations into Execution; -His Majesty taking the fame into his most ferious Confideration, and being defirous of doing every Thing in his Power towards putting a Stop to the faid Distemper, which, if not timely prevented, may end in the entire Destruction of the Horned Cattle, hath therefore thought it proper, by and with the Advice of his Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, That a Prohibition be laid on the Buying, Selling or Removing of all lean Horned Cattle, not only in those Counties where the Diftemper now is or may hereafter happen to be, but in all the Counties throughout England; and to that End, that no Person do, from and after the twentieth Day of this Instant September, fend, drive or remove, or tause to be sent, driven or removed, any Ox, Bull, Cow, Calf, Steer or Heifer, out of any Town, Parish or Extraparochial Place, to any other Town, Parish, or Extraparochial Place what soever, within that Part of Great Britain called England, or do buy, sell, or expose; or offer to Sale;
