

DVICES having been received, that the Country about the Ab-Le bey of Tongerlo and Westerloo was infefted by a Company of Three Hundred Banditti and Deserters from both Armies, which had committed great Diforders, and that they were able to pillage the Villages and Gentlemens Houses, Orders were ent to Tiftelt, Zichem Dieft, Halem and Hereck, to stop all People without Exception, who attempted to pais the Bridges erected on the Rivers, because there is great Reason to believe that the greatest Part of the Banditti on the other Side would join themselves to the Landheeren, a Name which those Fellows give themselves, who keep in the Country of Dagland, which comprehends the Towns situated between the Demer and the Dyle. Braffels, Aug. 25, N. S.
