HE following Address of the Mayor, Aldermen, Burgesses and Principal Inhabitants of the Town and County of Poole, has been presented to his Majesty by Joseph Gulston, Esq; one of their Representatives in Parliament. Which Address his Majesty was pleased to receive very graciously.

Publick a new Tax of 6 per Cent. upon Eftates in Land, as well as upon the Money which People have in the Publick Funds; which Tax is to be paid in the Space of two Years, and at fixt Times, to defray the Expences of the new Roads to Bologna, the working at which has been interrupted during the Depth of the Winter, but is now undertaken again with great Diligence. Madrid, April 7, N.S.' The Marquis de Tabuerniga arrived here from England on the 3d Instant, and is this Morning to be introduced to their Catholick Majesties and the Royal Family. The Bishop of Rennes is to leave Madrid on the 14th; and M. de Sada, formerly Amballador from this Court to the King of Sardinia, afterwards Governor of Savoy during the War, is to return to that Embaffy. Hague, April 22, N.S. The States of Holland have taken the Resolution to raise the Sum of 8,800,000 Florins, by Means of a Lottery of Obligations. One Half of the Subscription is to be furnished in ready Money, and the other Half in Old Obligations upon this Province. Two Placarts were published last Saturday in the Name of the States of Holland : The first confifts of Eleven Articles befides the Preamble, and ordains, that the Laws for the Regulation of the feveral Trades and Callings exercised in this Province, which were contained in the Ordonnances for levying of the Duties that used to be farmed by the Pachters, shall remain in their full Force, and be executed as before the Suppreffion of the Farms, in order to prevent the Confusion and Diforder which without those Laws would be unavoidable, and occasion the utter Ruin of the Persons who exercise the abovefaid Trades. The other Placart renews the Orders that have been hitherto observed with Regard to the retailing of divers Commodities; and authorizes the Officers of the Cuftoms, and the Masters and Wardens of the several Trading Companies, to fearch all Veffels and Carriages which they may suspect with being laden with prohibited Commodities.
