AT the Court at Kensington the 26th Day of July, 1749.

P R E S E N T, The King's most Excellent Majesty in Council. His Majesty in Council was this Day pleased to order, That the Parliament which stands prorogued to Thursday the Third of August next, be further prorogued to Thursday the Fourteenth Day of September following. to their Catholick Majesties in that Capacity. His Excellency had afterwards Audience of her Highness the Infanta Donna Maria Antonia, in her Apartment. The Count de Bene, late Minister from this Court to that of Dresden, arrived here on the 18th Instant, and was Yesterday presented to their Catholick Majesties.

Sconstantinople, June 19, N. S. The Prefents fent by the Emperor and Empress to the Grand Seignor, amounting to between 40 and 50,000 Dollars, have been delivered in a publick Audience by the Imperial Minister, and were extremely well received. There is fome Advice received from Erzerum at Aleppo, as if Mirza Ibrahim was fled, or had made his Peace with Shawrooke Schach, and even join'd him, fo that this latter remain'd fole Possessor of the Throne of Perfia. A Caravan is gone from Aleppo to Bagdat with 300 Bales of English Cloth. Haggy Mehemet, Pascha of Babylon, has entered that City: His first Execution was the Bazirgan to the Corps of Janizaries; a Jew offer'd 100 Purfes of Money to fave his Head, but without Effect; he has also deposed the Janizar Aga; and it is now hoped, by this Means, that the Grand Seignor's Government will be firmly eftablished in that Province.

Madrid, July 21, N. S. The Court has received the agreeable News of the Arrival of the Flota, confifting of five Ships of War, and ten Merchantmen, under the Command of Admiial Reggio, at Ferról, on the 12th Inftant: They are faid to have brought twenty-three Millions of Dollars in Specie, with a very large Quantity of Cochineal, as well as Indico, &c. They left the Havana the 13th of May laft. The 15th Inftant arrived here his Excellency the Chevalier d'Offorio, Ambaffador from the Court of Turin to his Catholick Majesty; and on the 18th he prefented his Credential Letters
