Florence, August 1, N.S. We are informed from Parma, that Preparations are making in that City for the Reception of Don Philip's Spouse, who has fixt her Departure from France for Lombardy to the 15th Instant. They are also repairing the Palace and Garden's of Colorno, where Don Philip defigns to pais the Autumn. The fame Letters mention the Duke of Modena's being on his Departure from Venice for his own State. Hague, August 21, N. S. Yesterday the States of Holland and Weftfrizeland commenced their Affembly. Count Bentinck, with Meff. de Rhoon and Pendregt, are returned hither from Bruffels, where they have been to compliment Prince Charles of Lorrain on the Part of the States General; and this Morning they made a Report of their Commission to the Assembly of their High Mightinesse. Mess. Bleyswyk and Godyn, who have been in Quality of Commiffaries to fettle the Tax of the Tenth Penny upofi the Maese, are likewise returned hither, and have made a Report of their Commission to the Council of State. The Prince of Orange has lately disposed of several Militarý Vacancies. An Ordonnance has been published within these few Days, containing feveral Regulations relating to the Subordination to be observed amongst the Officers of the respective Regiments of the Troops of this State. We hear that the Baron de Borflelen had changed, on the 17th of this Month, by Virtue of the Full Powers he had received from the Prince Stadtholder, the Magistrates of Sluys, and that he fet out the next Day for Sas van Ghent, in order to change likewife the Magistracy of that Place.

Naples, July 22, N. S. The Palace of the Principality of Calerta, lately purchased by the King, is repairing for his Majesty, who designs foon to fet out thither to take the Divertion of hunting. Thirty-fix of the Ringleaders of the Country People of the Village of Lavrino, who had the Boldness to fet Fire to **a** Forest in that Neighbourhood, after it had been declared to be for the King's private Hunting, were fent Prisoners to this City on the 18th by M. Riccardo, the Fifcal of Salerno, who, with a Detachment of Soldiers, was expresly fent thither to make a criminal Process. On the 19th, 23 Soldiers of the Regiment of Italian Foot Guards deferted ; they were Part of the Soldiers lately difinified out of the Swifs Regiment Wirtz, and who had afterwards inlifted in that of the faid Italian Guards. The Merchants of this City are fitting out a second large Settee to cruize against the Barbary Pirates, who still continue greatly to interrupt our Commerce. Rome, July 26, N.S. On the 21st about 30 Knights belonging to the Gallies of Malta, who lately anchored at Porto D'Anzio, arrived in this City, and on the 22d were introduced to an Audience of the Pope, who prefented each of them with a Gold Medal.
