IN Return for the Presents received from Algiers by the Deputy of that Regency, the Grand Signor has given them some Cannon and Ammunition, with a Liberty to purchase any other Stores.

Turin, October 25, N. S. Count de Canales, his Sardinian Majesty's Envoy to the Court of Vienna; who has been there some Time on his private Affairs, intends to set out in a Week or ten Days on his Return to that Court.

Stockholm, Nov. 1. Advice having been received that the Russians had given Orders for disarming their Ships of War at Cronstadt and Revel, the like Orders, with respect to our Fleet, have been sent from this Court to Carelscöon; and a Stop has also been put to the Preparations which were making for sending a large Body of Troops into Finland. The Baron de Hopken, whom the King has appointed his Minister to the King of Poland, as Elector of Saxony, in the room of the Baron de Greiffenheim, having received his last Instructions, set out a few Days ago for Dresden. The Marquis de Grimaldi, Minister Plenipotentiary from the Court of Spain, is arrived here, and has already waited on his Majesty and the Prince Successor.

Vienna, Nov. 1, N. S. Several Expresses have arrived at Schonbrun within these few Days past, and divers Councils have been held to deliberate on their Dispatches. The Regiment of Schulenburg, and that of Saxe-Gotha, are of the Number of those who are ordered to march into Italy. The Chevalier-de Tron, the new Venetian Ambassador, had his first Audiences of their Imperial Majesties on the 30th past, in which he delivered his Credential Letters. We have received Advice that Count Brown, Governor of Transilvania, was arrived at Hermanstadt on the 20th of last Month.

Copenhagen, Nov. 3. Amongst the Promotions made by the King on the Occasion of the late Jubilee, his Majesty conferred the Order of the Elephant on the eldest Son of the Duke of Holstein Sonderbourg; and the Count de Daneskiold Samsøe, Count Scheele, Count d'Isenbourg, and Major General Ulrichsdalh, had the

Order of Dannebrock conferred on them. The Duke of Saxe Hildburghausen, and his Dutchess, set out this Day for Germany.

Dresden, Nov. 4, N. S. The Court continues its Residence at St. Hubertsbourg. They write from Moravia, that the Troops which were in Quarters in those Parts had been reinforced with 12 Squadrons, and that four Regiments of Infantry had received Orders to post themselves on the Frontiers of that Province; and it is said the Court will soon give Orders for divers Forts to be erected on the Frontiers of Lithuania and Courland.

Dusseldorp, Nov. 4, N. S. The Recruits which have been raised in the Empire, and in several Places of this Neighbourhood, march off from hence successively towards the Brisgaw, which makes it believed they are intended to complete the Imperial Troops in Italy.

Paris, Nov. 7, N. S. The King proposes to set out on the 13th Instant for Choisy, where he intends to spend two or three Days, after which he will go to the Castle of Trianon, and from thence to Versailles for the Winter.

Berlin, Nov. 8, N. S. On the 4th Instant his Majesty came hither from Potzdam, and soon after his Arrival gave Audience to Baron de Rosenkrantz, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of Denmark, who then presented his Credential Letters; and the next Day he had his Audience of the two Queens, and of the Prince and Princess of Prussia. The 5th his Majesty set out on his Return to Potzdam, where he proposes to stay some Time, before he comes to reside here for the Winter.

Hambourg, Nov. 11, N. S. The Duke of Hildburghausen, with the Princess Royal, his new Consort, and Sister to the King of Denmark, arrived last Night at Altona. They have been complimented To-day by Deputies from this City, and their Highnesses will proceed on their Journey, in a few Days, to the Duke's Place of Residence.

Hague, Nov. 14, N. S. Their High Mightinesses the States of Holland and West Frizeland opened their Assembly on the 12th Instant, and Yesterday his Serene Highness the Prince of Orange assisted thereat; after which his Highness went on board the States Yacht for Leuwarden, where he proposes to stay two or three Days, and
