Petersburg, July 21.

ER Imperial Majefty having fignified her Pleasure, that the Court should continue at Petershoff for some Weeks longer, feveral of the Foreign Ministers are preparing to go thither.

Naples, July 21. The King's Half Gallies, which are stationed on the Coast of Sicily, having received Notice, that two small Xebecks, Corfairs from Baibary, had feized two Nea-'polstan Barks near Trapani, immediately went in quest of them, and on the 4th Instant, after a fhort Engagement, took one of the Corfairs with their Prize, but the other made her Elcape. On the 9th Inftant their Majesties, with the Royal Family, attended by their respective Retinues and Guards, returned to "this City from Portici, in perfect Health On the 12th anchored in this Port, from a Cruize in the Adriatick Sea, two of the King's Half Gal-"lies, which are to effort the King to the Ifland of Procida, where he proposes to go to shoot Pheafants. Rome, July 25. By Order from the Pope, the Companies of Soldiers in this City are to be augmented to the Number of 100 Men each, difmi fing from them the Invalids, who are fent to St. Sifto, in lieu of whom, and to compleat the faid Companies, they are actually inlifting Men. **T**is faid that M. Gufman, who is fhortly expected here, has been appointed by the King of Portugal to fucceed the late M. Sampario, his Minifter to the Pope. 'On the 11th Inftant Cardinal Mellini had a particular Audience of the Pope, in'Confequence of a Dispatch which he received from Vienna, relating to the Affair of Aquileja. Several Perfons having petitioned for Leave to the plentiful Harvest this Year throughout the Ecclefiaftical State, the Pope has granted their Request, on Condition of their paying the usual Duties On Exportation; "and 'tis faid a large Quantity has already been contracted for to be fent to Leghorn. Parma, July 25. Some curious Fireworks are preparing at Colorno, which are to be played. off on the 14th of next Month, being the Birth-Day of the Infanta Dutches, who then enters into the 24th Year of her Age; and is imagined her Highness's Pregnancy will that Day be declared at Court. Florence, July 29. All Difficulties having been removed for the Ceremony of bleffing the fidor to this Court, were fent away for Paris

Colours of the Emperor's three Ships of War, by a provisional Decree which the Archbishop of Pifa had made for that Purpose, and which was afterwards approved of by the Pope, that Ceremony was performed on the 9th Instant by M. Cerrati, Chaplain of the Order of St. Stephen, who afterwards celebrated Mass in the Cabbin of the Commodore's Ship; on which Occasion M. Acton entertained at Dinner, and with a Ball, many Ladies and Gentlemen who were invited to that Ceremony. On the 16th at Night, the Eagle and Heron, two of the faid Ships of War. failed for Porto Ferraio, conducting thither Count Richecourt, to view the Fortifications of that Port and the Salines, and returned from thence to Leghorn on the 20th Instant, On the 13th M. Richard, one of the Secretaries of the Council of the Regency, fet out from Leghorn for Genoa, to receive from that Government, agreeable to the Emperor's Directions, a Xebeck Corfair from Tunis, which in November last was taken by two Genoese armed Barks from under a fmall Fort near the Port of Leghorn. Posnania, July 29. For some Days past there has appeared in the Neighbourhood of this City, a prodigeous Quantity of Locusts, which makes People very uneafy leaft they fhould make the fame Devastation they did last Year. Notwithstanding the Troops which have been fent into the Ukraine, to prevent the Heyducks plundering that Country, are almost continually in Motion, yet numberless Disorders are still committed by them, the Troops not being able to drive them out of the thick Woods in which they take Shelter. We learn from Warfaw, that the Rrimate of that Kingdom had been very much indifposed for some Days past. The same Letters fay, that the Deputies from the feveral export Corn into foreign Parts, on account of Provinces of that Kingdom were daily arriving, in order to affift at the holding of the extraordinary Diet, which there was good Reason to believe would prove fuccessful. We have received Advice, that a contagious Diftemper has broke out again in some of the Provinces bordering upon Russia, and has carried off a great Number of Perfons, Vienna, Aug. 1, Yesterday several of the Nobility, and other Persons of Distinction, went to Schonbrun, to take Leave of Prince Charles of Lorrain, who, 'tis now faid, intends to Tet. out for Bruffels, by the Way of Bohemia, on Monday next.
