AT the Court at Kensington, the 4th Day of September, 1751,

PRESENT, The King's most Excellent Majesty in Council.

That no Pilot shall go on Board any Ship or Vessel obliged to perform Quarantine, in order to conduct the fame into any Port or Place, but shall perform such Service in some other Boat or Vessel, which Boat or Vessel shall keep as much to the Windward of the Ship or Veffel fo to be conducted as possible; and if any Pilot or other Person shall go on Board such Ship or Veffel, fuch Pilot or other Perfon shall perform Quarantine, in like Manner as any Perfon coming in fuch Ship or Veffel shall be obliged to perform the fame. That if at the Expiration of the Forty Days Quarantine to be performed by any Ship or Veffel that is or shall be liable thereto, it shall appear to the Officers of the Cultoms in the Place where fuch Ship or Veffel shall be, and the Master or other Persons taking Charg eof fuch Ship or Veffel, together with two other Perfons belonging to the faid Ship or Veffel, shall make Oath before the Customer, Comptroller or Collector of the Port where fuch Quarantine shall be performed, or the next Port thereunto, or before any of their Deputies, or any one Justice of the Peace near adjoining to fuch Port, or (where fuch Quarantine shall have been performed within any of the faid Ifles of Jersey, Guernsey, Alderney, Sark, or Man) before any two Jurates or Magistrates of any of the faid Isles respectively, That such Ship or Veffel, and all and every Perfon and Perfons therein have duly performed their Quarantine as aforefaid, and that the Ship or Vessel, and all the Persons on Board, are free from Infection, that then the respective Persons coming in such Ship or Vessel (a Certificate of such Oaths being made by the Perfons before whom the fame shall be taken) shall be permitted to go on Shore, but the Goods imported in fuch Ship or Veilel. together with the Bedding of the Sailors, shall be landed, opened and aired, and fo remain a Week, and after may be brought to the Places of their Discharge, other than Hemp and Flazz, Paper or Books, Silk raw, thrown or wrought, Linen, Cotton Wool, Cotton Yain, or manufactured, Wool raw, or in any wife wrought, Feathers, Grograin, or Mohair Yarn, Human Hair, Goats Hair, Carmenia Wool, Carpets, Camlets, Burdets, or other Manufactures of Silk and Cotton, Kid Skins, and Skins in the Wool or Hair, Spunges, Wine and Oil in Chefts, Thread Stockings, all Goods packed with Straw of Cotton, Straw Hats and Brushes, Matting

THEREAS his Majefty hath lately received Information, that the Plague hath for some Time past raged, and doth still continue to rage with the greatest Violence in Constantinople and in the Parts adjacent; and as it is of the utmost Importance to take the earlieft Measures to prevent the Contagion being brought by Goods or Perfons coming from any of the Places for infected, into this Kingdom, or the Isles of Jersey, Guernsey, Alderney, Sark and Man-His Majesty out of his great Case and tender Regard for the Prefervation of his People, is hereby pleafed, with the Advice of his Privy Council, to order, that all fuch Ships and Vef-Jels as are arrived from the Levant, and not yet unladen, or that shall hereafter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom, or of the Isles of Jer-, ley, Guernsey, Alderney, Sark or Man, from the Levant, do make their Quarantine for Forty Days, which are to commence and be computed from the Day each Ship or-Veffel shall " come to Anchor in the Place appointed for performing fuch Quarantine, and not before.

That the Place for performing Quarantine by such Ships and Vessels bound to the Rivers of Thames and Medway, be Standgate Creek son the South of the River Medway, oppofite to the Isle of Grain; and by such Ships and Veffels coming into any other of the Ports of Great Britain, be such Places as shall be appointed by the Officers of his Majefty's Cuftons in such Ports, who are hereby impowered and required to appoint proper Places for the lame; and that the Places for performing Quarantine within any Port of the faid Isles of Jeifey, Guernsey, Alderney, Sark or Man, be uch Places as shall be appointed by the respective Governors or Deputy Governors of the faid respective Isles, who are hereby impowered and required to appoint proper Places for the lame, That until and during the Time for making Juch Quarantine, no Perion coming, or Goods imported in any fuch Ship or Veffel, shall come on Shore, or be landed in any Place within this Kingdom, or any of the faid Isles.
