

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to the Statute made in the Eighth Year of the Reign of his present Majesty, intituled, An Act for the Amendment of the Law relating to Actions on the Statute of Hue and Cry, That James Light, of Hursley in the County of Southampton, Grocer, was robbed on Tuesday the 6th Day of this Instant March, between the Hours of Twelve and One at Noon, on the King's Highway leading between Hursley aforesaid and the City of Winchester in the said County, as he was travelling along the same, in the Parish of Saint Faith's, in the Hundred of Buddlegate in the said County, of six Pieces of Gold Coin called Portugal Pieces, each of the Value thirty six Shillings, and Eight Guineas and an Half of English Gold Coin, which he had in a yellow Canvas Bag in his Breeches Pocket, by a Man on Foot, about five Feet six Inches high, in a brown Fustian Frock with flat white Metal Buttons, green Plush Breeches, a blue Mark on his Right Hand Wrist, and with either Hair or Wig, in Company with another Man on Foot, who stood at a small Distance, who wore his own Hair, and made off immediately after the said Robbery with the other Person who so robbed the said James Light.
