Dresden, Feb. 28. M. Calkoen, Minister Plenipotentiary from the States General of the United Provinces, had on Sunday last a private Audience of the King, in order to communicate to his Majesty the Contents of some Dispatches he had received from his Court ; after which he had a long Conference with the prime Minister Count Bruhl. The King has promoted Count Cofel, M. de Wilfter, Count Maurice de Bruhl, Master of the Horse, Prince Eugene of Anhalt Deffau, and Count Flemming, Minister Plenipotentiary from this Court to that of Vienna, to the Rank of Generals of his Forces; and at the fame Time his Majesty raised eight Colonels to the Rank of Majors General. Schaffhousen, March 4. 'Tis now confidently afferted, that a Negociation is on the Tapis between the King of Prussia and the Canton of Berne, by which his Pruffian Majesty is to deliver up the Principality of Neufchatel to that Canton, in Confideration of their paying him a certain Sum of Money. Berlin, March 5. Count Finkenstein, Colonel of a Regiment of Foot, and one of the King's Aids de Camp, has follicited and obtained Leave to quit his Majesty's Service. Bruffels, March 7. Prince Ligne is appointed to affift as Prefident of the Affembly of the States of Luxembourg, in the Room of Field Marshal Count Neuperg, who is still at Vienna. Last Monday Morning died at his Seat at Heverla near Louvain, the Duke of Arembourg, Commander in Chief of all their Imperial Majefties Forces in the Auftrian Low Countries. Hague, March 12. The States of Holland and Westfrizeland, who separated on Saturday last, have agreed to the raising the ordinary Supplies for the Service of the prefent Year; and they have likewife agreed to the Proposition made to them by her Royal Highnels the Princess Governante, for taking off half a Verponding or Tax upon Houses for this Year. M. Gravestein having been appointed to the Office of Receiver of the Convoys and Licences of the Town of Grave and its Diffrict, he has taken the usual Oaths before their High Mightiness to qualify himself for that Employment. The Directors of the Company trading to Surinam, have conferred the Government of that Colony on M. vander Meer, Major of the Regiment of Horfe of Birkenfeld, which Choice 'tis imagined will not only be agreeable to the Princes Governante, but also to the States General.
