Hospital for Invalids at Pelt in Hungary. A large Body of new Recruits, raifed in this City and its Neighbourhood, are speedily to march from hence for Hungary, in order to join the different Regiments they are inlifted for. Prague, Aug. 24. Yesterday their Imperial Majefties arrived here from the Camp at Kollin, where they spent five Days in viewing the Troops, and leeing them go through their Exercife. We also expect the Three Princeffes to arrive this Year from Tranquebar; but as to the Sudermanland, the is not expected till the Middle of next Summer. Coffel, Aug. 26. The Landgrave dur Sovereign has agreed to a Cartel with the Court of Dreiden, and to another with Prince Waldeck, for the mutual Exchange of Deferters. Madrid, Aug. 26. Last Monday 'a Courler from Lifbon having brought the melancholy News of the Death of the Queen Dowager of Portugal, Mother to the Queen of Spain, their Catholick Majesties were pleased to order the Court to go into Mourning for fix Months. Yesterday the Cardinal Infant arrived here from St. Ildephonfo, in order, as it is faid, to refign, with the King's Leave, the two Archbishopricks of Toledo and Seville. The Marquis de Coria, only Son to the Duke of Huescar, who has been ill of the Small Pox, is out of Danger. By Letters from Cadiz we are informed, that four Men of War, belonging to the Portuguese Squadron, that was lately in that Port, were returned thither, in order to take in Provisions ; after which they were to proceed upon a Cruize off Algiers, Hague, Sept. 5. The States of this Province separated to Day, and are hot to meet again till Wednesday the 25th Instant.
