The Lords of His Majesty's most Honourable Privy Council.

WHereas the Time limited by His Majefty's Order in Council, of the 28th of February last, for paying the respective Bounties therein mentioned, to all Able and Ordinary Seamen, and also to all Able-bodied Landmen, who should voluntarily enter themselves in His Majefty's Royal Navy; And likewife for paying the Rewards to Perfons difcovering Seamen who should conceal themselves, will expire upon the 31ft Day of this Instant March.-And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majefty's Service, That the Bounties and Rewards thereby given should be continued to be paid for fome Time longer : - It is there-upon this Day Ordered in Council, that the Bounties of Three Pounds for every Able Seaman, and of Thirty Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, not above the Age of Fifty, nor under the Age of Twenty Years; and of Thirty Shillings for every Able-bodied Landman, not above the Age of Thirty-five, nor under the Age of Twenty Years, be continued to be paid to fuch Seamen and Landmen respectively, who shall, on or before the 30th Day of April next, enter themfelves in the Royal Navy, in the Manner directed by His Majefty's Proclamation of the 11th Day of November laft. And likewife that the Rewards of Two Pounds for every Able, and Twenty Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, be continued to be paid to any Perfons who shall, on or before the faid 30th Day of April next, discover any Seaman or Seamen, who shall conceal themselves, fo as fuch Seaman or Seamen be taken for His Majefty's Service. Whereof all Perfons concerned are to take Notice, and govern them-felves accordingly. W. Sharpe.

Brussels, March 23. The Regiments of Beauvoifis and Lionnois marched on the 13th and 15th Instant for Brittany, the first from Landrecies and the other from Valenciennes. Thirty-fix Waggons have been lately fent from Douay to Dunkirk with Bullets and Gun Powder, and the French Work Night and Day in all their Arfenals, Marshal Duke de Richelieu, the Duke de Mirepoix, and all the other General Officers who are appointed to command on the Coasts of the Mediterranean, set out from Paris on Thursday last, the 18th Instant. M. de Moncalm, who is to command the French Troops in Canada, fet out for Breft the 15th Instant, after having been advanced to the Rank of a Major General.
