Constantinople, May 15. The Vizir arrived here on the 3d Inftant ; fince that Time he has been occupied with receiving ceremonious Vifits, and regulating the Price of Provisions, The Caimachan has reaffumed his for-&c. The Foreign mer Post of Janizar Aga. Ministers began their publick Audiences on the 10th. The Venetian Ambaffador, Cavalier Dona, having received the Prefents that Republick fends the Sultan, has taken upon him the Character of Ambaffador Extraordinary, and notified as such to the Porte and Foreign Ministers. As the Ramezan is approaching, he has already made his publick Entry, and this Day had his Audience of the Vizir, and on Tuefday he will have that of the Grand Seignor. Prince Dolghorucky, the Russian Envoy Extraordinary, who is fent by the Empress to compliment the Sultan on his Acceffion, arrived here on the 6th, and the next Day notified as usual; both he, and the Polish Envoy Count Mnifzeck, expect to have their publick Audiences before Ramezan, which begins the 29th Inftant.

Copenhagen, June 7. The King is expected from Holftein fome Time next Week. A Placard is published here, prohibiting, under fevere Penalties, the Exportation of all Kinds of Grain out of Denmark and Norway till the End of September next.

Drefden, June 13. On Wednefday last the 9th Instant, his Polish Majesty set out for Kargau, an Estate in Poland belonging to Count Unruh, Twenty-four German Miles from this

Place, where he arrived that Evening, and figned the Universalia for the Diet; and the next Day returned here. The Prince of Schwartzenberg arrived here a few Days ago, in order to execute a Commission from their Imperial Majesties. The Saxon Commissions returned here from Halle a few Days ago.

Their Highnesses the three young Princes of Hesse-Casses, who have been here during the King of Denmark's Stay at Altona, set out Yesserday Morning on their Return to Gottingue. His Danish Majesty has made a Present to each Prince of a Gold Snuff-Box set with Diamonds to a considerable Value: And to the Duke of Saxe-Hilbourgshausen, Brother-in-law to the King, of a Gold Watch fet with Brilliants.

Amflerdam, June 16. The Admiralty has caufed publick Notice to be given, that the Phœnix Man of War, commanded by Captain van Stocken, will fail from the Texel, the firft fair Wind after the 1ft of July next, for the Levant, in order to convoy the Trade bound for those Parts.

Hague, June 17. Her Royal Highness the Princess Governance has appointed M. Haubner to be Comptroller General of the Artillery, in the Room of M. vander Lingen, who has obtained Leave to refign. By our last Advices from Dieren, the eldest Princess Dowager of Orange is arrived there, and proposes staying till her Royal Highness the Princess Governance and her Children return to the Hague.
