Republick, that an Imperial Regiment of Huffars, one of Dragoons, ten Battalions of Infantry, and ten Companies of Grenadiers, were about to march through Verona, in their Road to Bohemia.

Bruffels, Sept. 28. The Auftrian Troops in the Netherlands, which are intended to take the Field, are continuing their Preparations for that Purpole. General Marschal was to set out Yesterday from Luxembourg, having been ordered to repair immediately to Olmutz in Moravia, of which Place he has been lately appointed Governor. He ftill retains, however, the Govern-ment of the Town and Dutchy of Luxem-bourg.
