Admiralty-Office, March 9. Aptain Lambert, of His Majesty's Sloop the Jamaica, is arrived at Spithead with the Cabriolet, a French Privateer of Dunkirk, carrying fix Guns, and fifty one Men, which he took off Havre de Grace.

Whereas it has been bumbly represented to the King, That divers Robberies, Burglaries and Thests, howe, of late Years, been committed within the several Counties of Esfex, Hertford, Cambridge, and Suffolk; to the great Injury of the respective Inbaliants of those Counties; and that, by the Care and Vigilance of second veral Gentlemen in the Commission of the Peace for the County of Esfex, aforesaid, A Gang of the said Robbers bas been discovered; Seven of whom, being already taken, are committed to Chelmsford Goal; and, upon Informations, which have been given, diligent Search is making after the Others; His Majesty, for the better discovering, and bringing to Justice, the remaining Persons of the said Gang, (bereunder described, and not yet taken) is, bereby, pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon, as also a Reward of One Hundred Pounds, to any One of them, who shall discover the Rest of the said Gang of Persons, bereunder described, or any Two, or more of them, so that they may be apprehended and convicted of any, or either, of the Robberies, Burg-laries, or Thefis aforementioned: The faid Reward to be paid by the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, upon the Conviction of any Two, or more, of the Offenders.

Descriptions of the Persons not yet taken, and against auhom Informations have been given, for the Robberies committed as above, viz.

WILLIAM SALMON, of Thaxted, Jobber, about 28 Years of Age, 5 Feet 10 or 11 Inches high; well made, with grey Eyes, a ruddy Complexion, light colour'd curled Hair, and a Dimple in his Chin .- Supposed to have gone off in light coloured Cloths.

JACOB MURTON, of Thaxted, Butcher, about 35 Years of Age, 5 Feet 9 or 10 Inches high, throng Built, 2 round Face, full dark Eyes, brown Eyebrows, his own short brown Hair.—Supposed to have gone off in a Blue-grey Coat.

JAMES CARDINAL, of Thaxted, Cordwainer,

about 25 Years of Age, a down Look, a black Complexion, dark Eyes and very full black Eyebrows, a short Nose, rather rising at the Point, thick Lips, a large Mouth, large Nostrils, full Beard, and dimpled Chin; lately wore his own black Hair, but

went off in a brown Wig.

ALLEN LUNN, of Thaxted, Heel Maker, about 30 Years of Age, 5 Feet 8 Inches high, a brown Complexion, Light-grey Eyes, thin made, and a thin Beard, except on his Upper-Lip, where it is very strong and full.—Went off in a Grey Cut

WILLIAM BELCHAM, of Hemsted, Labourer, about 40 Years of Age, a short, thick, well-set Man, full faced, dark brown lank Hair.

Admiralty Office, December 26, 1758: Y Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, Y Lords Comminutes of the having received authentick Information, that a Galliot or Vessel, called the Justrow Christina Elizabeth of Lubeck, whereof Casper Muntzenberger was Master, laden with different Kinds of Goods and Merchandize, belonging to the Subjects of the Empress of Russia, and bound from Rouen to St. Petersbourg; was, in the Course of her faid Voyage, on the 18th Day of September last, boarded three several Times by the Crews, or Part of the Crews, of fix English Ships or Vessels, being, or pretending to be Privateers; and that at the first of those Times, viz. about One a-Clock in the Afternoon of that Day, some of the Crews of the said English Ships boarded the faid Galliot off Dungeness, and opening the Fore Hatchway, went into the Hold, and broke open a great many Cases, and Packs of Merchandize, and unlawfully took, and carried away, great Quantities of Velvets, Silks, Silk-Stockings, Gloves, Confectionary Goods, and one whole Bale of Silk: And that between Three and Four a Clock in the same Afternoon, being off Dover, the said Galliot was again boarded by the Crews, or Part of the Crews, of three other English Ships, who being in Company, went together into the Hold, and rummaged the faid Galliot, and unlawfully took, and carried away, some Silk, and Silk-Stockings, Part of which they wrapped about their Bodies, and put the rest into their Pockets, and also took away a Sword: And that foon afterwards, on the same Day, the faid Galliot was a third Time boarded by the Crew, or Part of the Crew of another English Ship, who went into the Hold, broke open feveral Cafes, and unlawfully took, and carried away, two Boatloads of Merchandize, confisting of Men and Women's Velvets, Silk, embroidered Cloaths, Silk-Stockings, Leather Gloves, French-Plate Candleflicks, some Swords, and Hangers, Bottles of Cordials, Perfumes, and Confectionary and other Goods; nad then beat feveral of the faid Galliot's Crew, and confined the faid Master in his Cabbin, placing a Centry over him with Pistols :

Their Lordships therefore, in order to discover and bring to Justice, the Persons guilty of the Piratical Offences above-mentioned, are pleased to promife a Reward of FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS,
